

JOINT TOWN BOARDS OF BERRY & SPRINGFIELD SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES – SITE VISIT

Saturday, Nov. 7, 2020, 9:00 A.M. Site Visit

Location: 5628 Whippoorwill Rd., Cross Plains, WI

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Chair Jim Pulvermacher called the Springfield meeting to order at 8:58 a.m. Chair Varda called the Berry meeting to order.

Roll call shows:

Chair Pulvermacher and Supervisors Bill Statz, Art Meinholz and Dan Dresen present for the Town of Springfield; Sup. Laufenberg was absent.

Chair Varda and Supervisors Mike Statz, Christine Molling, and Duane Haag present for the Town of Berry; Sup. Evert was not in attendance.

Also present were Brad Meinholz, Jake Niesen and Janel Niesen.

2. CONFIRMATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETINGS LAW

The Clerk confirmed to Chairperson Pulvermacher in advance that the agenda was posted at town hall and on the Town website.

3. TOUR AND DISCUSSION OF GROUNDS AND PROPERTY

The group toured the grounds discussing the pros and cons of various locations for a cul de sac. Town of Berry supervisors indicated they won't help fund a cul de sac if it's not located at the bottom of the knoll where the existing town of Berry road right of way (ROW) ends; unfortunately, the town of Berry residents won't contribute land for the turn around and supervisors don't want to acquire the land by eminent domain. To place the cul de sac at the top of the knoll, the Springfield resident has indicated he will donate the land for the cul de sac to the town. Special assessments to existing or future land owners may be considered, as well as increased costs for driveway permits to access the cul de sac in the future.
