SPRINGFIELD TOWN BOARD MEETING TUESDAY, MAY 2, 2017, 7:30 P.M. SPRINGFIELD TOWN HALL

<u>Call to Order, Roll Call, Pledge of Allegiance</u> – Chair Don Hoffman called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Roll call shows Supervisors Dave Laufenberg, Jim Pulvermacher, Art Meinholz and Dan Dresen present. Also present were Deputy Clerk Jan Barman, Road Patrolman Darin Ripp, Elizabeth Koehl, Bob Dreps, Julie Loeffler and Elliott Long. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

<u>Confirmation of Compliance with Open Meetings Law</u> – Deputy Clerk Barman confirmed that the agenda was posted at the town hall and on the website. Meeting is being recorded.

Informal Public Comment Time – Bernie Lange, Tri-North Builders needs to add on to the loading dock area as the semis are having a difficult time making the turns to back into the dock, Lot 12 Springfield Corners Commercial Center. The storm water pond is accurate to handle the additional impervious area. The board mentioned that the entrances are not up to our code and Bernie will work with Darin to correct them. The board suggested Bernie return to the next board meeting for action. Julie Loeffler asked what the problems were with Dane County zoning, she had talked to an attorney from the Town of Berry that there are proponents of opting out, costs and benefits need to be considered. Julie would like to see everyone work together and get along. Don mentioned that the Chairs and Clerks from the opting out towns will be meeting to set up procedures, so they are uniform.

Minutes of previous meeting: Board meeting on April 19, 2017. - Motion made by (Dresen/Pulvermacher) to approve minutes for April 19, 2017 with corrections. Under public comment time – Pulvermacher stated that the board was never in favor of the residents not voting on this issue, and under Breakfast on the Farm, buses will run from Hwy 12 & 19 Park-N-Ride and St Andrew Church. <u>Candidate for Plan Commission – Elliott Long</u>

Chair Hoffman has decided, with the backing of the board, for a variety of reasons not to re-appoint Elliott Long to the Plan Commission.

Julie Loeffler commented that serving on the board and commission are thankless jobs and they could be home spending time with their families but they are serving the people of this town and doing a great job and she appreciates it.

Dan Dresen said all that is bought up is the opting out, what about other issues, why isn't there any discussion or interest in that.

Elizabeth Koehl was upset after annual meeting and has been attending the board meetings since then and she appreciates all the work the board has done before as well as currently.

Julie – bridge the division but respects the board.
