

1 RESOLUTION 2023-3 CREATING TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AGAINST CONSTRUCTION AND OTHER HEAVY
2 TRAFFIC ON GREENBRIAR ROAD, TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

4 WHEREAS, the Redtail Ridge Subdivision is under construction in the City of Middleton and is
5 generating a large amount of construction traffic. The construction traffic includes many heavy trucks
6 and construction machines.


7 WHEREAS, in the absence of restrictions, construction traffic might use Greenbriar Road to reach
8 Highway 12, which would interfere with the use of that road by Town residents and cause wear and
9 damage to Greenbriar Road for no benefit to the Town.

10 WHEREAS, Wisconsin law allows the Town to impose special restrictions on weight and traffic;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of Springfield does hereby resolve as follows:

13 1. Pursuant to Wis. Stats. Secs. 349.16 (1)(b) and 349.17, the Town Board imposes the following
14 restrictions on the use of Greenbriar Road:

16 A. No construction traffic of any kind related to the Redtail Ridge Subdivision may travel on
17 Greenbriar Road.
18 B. No traffic with a gross vehicle weight (with or without load) of more than 30,000 pounds
19 may travel on Greenbriar Road, excepting therefrom, traffic travelling on Greenbriar
20 Road to and from the entrance road to Yahara Materials Quarry which is engaged in
21 business with the Quarry; emergency vehicles; road maintenance vehicles; snowplows
22 and farm machinery traveling directly to farm fields. The Town Chairman may grant
23 exceptions to this section by permit.
24 C. The restrictions of this section shall be communicated by appropriate signs posted at all
25 entrances to Greenbriar Road. The signs shall comply with the Manual on Uniform Traffic
26 Control Devices.
27 D. The restriction of this section shall continue in force until rescinded by the Town Board.
28 E. Violations may be enforced as weight limitation violations under the Town's Code of
29 Ordinances.
