NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS - AMENDED

REQUESTS FOR REZONING

Please take notice that the Plan Commission of the Town of Springfield will conduct a public hearing at town hall on the **9**th **day of June, at 6:30 p.m.** to receive public comment on the rezone request(s) for the following parcels:

Parcel Nos.(4): 0808-063-9384-0, 0808-063-9392-0, 0808-06309376-0, 0808-063-9368-0 Location: East side of Sutzfey Circle Kinney Irrev. Trust

The applicant is looking to rezone the four existing home lots from R-1 Legacy zoning to SFR Towns' zoning, and to halve one of the lots resulting in the creation of one new home lot which would also be zoned SFR.

Parcel No.: 0808-181-8110-0 Location: 5827 County Hwy. P Ryan & Chloe Faga

The applicants are applying to separate off farm acreage to the north and south of the farmhouse, requiring all three resultant parcels be rezoned from A-1EX Legacy zoning to EA (Exclusive Ag) Towns' zoning.

ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS

Double frontage lots –

This proposed amendment addresses the lack of definition/clarity on what is the "front" of a property when a property has two different roads touching the property and is not a corner lot.

Rural business district –

This amendment clears up some issues with residents who run, or want to operate a business that is a little more than a Home-Based Business but isn't quite a full-scale commercial business; amending the existing rural based business district to make it more robust as a way of facilitating start-up businesses. It creates a new zoning classification for Overlay Zoning districts, defines how those will work and allows existing zoning parcels to be mapped as Overlay Districts.
