MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, March 4, 2020, 7:00 P.M. Manure and Frac Tank Regulations Meeting Springfield Town Hall

1. CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL

Chair Jim Pulvermacher called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

- 2. CONFIRMATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETINGS LAW The Clerk confirmed that the agenda was posted at town hall and on the Town website.
- 3. INFORMAL PUBLIC COMMENT TIME None.
- 4. MANURE AND FRAC TANK REGULATIONS

The Board and attendees discussed safety and operational issues. A number of items were identified as sensical standard practices going forward for operators in the town. Operators will provide and place two orange road signs in both directions of traffic; a "One Lane Road Ahead" sign is required where applicable. Operators will notify the town of general areas of operation on an annual basis, and notify the Road Patrolman as early as practicable of any scheduled operations likely to notably impede traffic flow. Operators shall file annually with the town a Certificate of Insurance listing the Town of Springfield as an additional insured on their farm or general liability insurance and on their farm &/or business automobile coverage. Equipment located on the roads' shoulder must have an illuminated caution light attached; equipment off the shoulder but inside the utility poles need reflective markings. Pumping was briefly discussed, with supervisors willing to discuss in the future.
