

## MEETING MINUTES—Site Visit

Tuesday, June 8, 2021, 6:30 P.M. Town Board Meeting

Location: Greenbriar Lane & Hickory Trail Greenspace\*

\* across from 4954 Hickory Trl., between 4965 and 4943 Hickory Trail

### 1. CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL

Chair Jim Pulvermacher called the meeting to order on-site at Greenbriar Lane cul de sac at 6:30 p.m.

Roll call shows Chair Pulvermacher and Supervisors Dave Laufenberg, Matt Wright, Art Meinholz, and Dan Dresen present, along with three of the four landowners that live on Greenbriar Lane. Aside from the board, no one appeared at the greenspace.

### 2. CONFIRMATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETINGS LAW

The Clerk confirmed with the Chairman in advance of the meeting that the agenda was posted at town hall and on the Town website. Chairperson Pulvermacher is acting as clerk for the meeting.

# 3. <u>AUTHORIZE THE CONTENTS, DRAFTING, AND SENDING OF CORRESPONDENCE TO MIDDLETON COMMON</u> COUNCIL IN OPPOSITION TO MOREY AIRPORT EXPANSION

Chairperson Pulvermacher would like to draft and email a letter to the City of Middleton in advance of next week's board meeting and would like it to be from, and with the support of, the board. The board didn't object to drafting a letter, but would like to review before authorizing for distribution.

## 4. GREENBRIAR LANE ROAD CONDITION (6:30 P.M.—OFF OF GREENBRIAR ROAD)

Supervisors discussed maintenance options such as rebuilding and/or widening the end of the road to 60'. The culvert was replaced last year; the plow tore up the patch last winter, more patch is needed. Supervisors will need to discuss when to have the work done, as it wouldn't be this year. Supervisors left the site at 6:55 p.m. and continued over to the Hickory Trail greenspace.

### 5. HICKORY TRAIL GREENSPACE\* (IMMEDIATELY AFTER CONCLUSION AT GREENBRIAR LN)

Supervisors met across from 4954 Hickory Trail and entered the greenspace from the road. No residents were in attendance for this portion of the site visit to tour the property with the board. The board was able to walk back into the greenspace, using the unofficial, rough foot paths that have gradually developed to tour the lot for approximately twenty-five minutes.
